



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Approving a Business License to Tribal Member Lloyd Cheney, Sr.)


- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IV, Section 1(a) and 1(s) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, *inter alia*, the Tribal Council has the authority to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has the authority to issue business licenses, pursuant to the White Mountain Apache Business Code, Section 1.1 *et seq.*; and
- WHEREAS,** tribal member, Lloyd Cheney, Sr., has come before the Tribal Council to request a business license for the operation of Apache Trailz Hawley Lake; and
- WHEREAS,** Mr. Cheney intends to implement a Horse Stable/Riding Trail business on eight (8) acres of land currently allocated for the North Fork Livestock Association; and
- WHEREAS,** Mr. Cheney is has gone through the standard protocol and has received support from the TPPR Committee and Apache Enterprise; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council is supportive of tribal member-owned businesses and finds it to be in the best interests of the Tribe to grant Lloyd Cheney Sr. a business license so he may provide a Horse Stable/Riding Trail business on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a business license to tribal member, Lloyd Cheney, Sr. d/b/a Apache Trailz Hawley Lake.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **FEBRUARY 2, 2011** duly adopted by a vote of **TEN** for and **ZERO** against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
