



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**(Approval to enroll deceased infant Ta’Korii Qwanell Baha)**

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe (“Tribe”) is saddened by recent news that Tribal Members Mardy D. Baha and DeeAnna K. James’ minor child, Ta’Korii Qwanell Baha, has passed away; and

**WHEREAS,** though not yet enrolled, the deceased child qualifies for Tribal Membership pursuant to requirements set forth in the Enrollment Code and the Tribal Constitution; and

**WHEREAS,** the parents have requested that the Tribal Council approve the enrollment of their infant, so that the child may be eligible for funeral and burial expenses; and


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council supports Tribal Members during difficult times and finds it in the best interest of the Tribe and Mardy D. Baha and Deanna K. James, to authorize the enrollment of the late Ta’Korii Qwanell Baha.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants Tribal Membership to Ta’Korii Qwanell Baha, pursuant to the Enrollment Code and Tribal Constitution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on APRIL 7, 2011 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
