



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Recommending Eddie Hastings Employment at Housing Authority)


- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") has listened to the concerns of a Tribal Member, Eddie Hastings regarding his employment search and available opportunities that currently exist within the Housing Authority; and
- WHEREAS,** White Mountain Apache Housing Authority ("Housing Authority"), including Gladys Bencomo and Elizabeth Perry were present for the meeting and advised the Tribal Council that employment was not available to match Mr. Hastings' skill-set; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council supports its Tribal Members and encourages them to seek employment vigorously, to benefit themselves, their families and the greater Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Housing Authority is an independent entity operating under the umbrella of the White Mountain Apache Nation for the benefit of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to recommend Eddie Hastings for the next available position at the Housing Authority that he is qualified to assume.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby recommends to Housing Authority management that they strongly consider hiring Tribal Member Eddie Hastings for the next position that he is qualified to work for at the Housing Authority.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on MAY 11, 2011 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against and TWO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
