



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Adopting Non-Tribal Member Hunting Regulations for 2011-2012)


- WHEREAS,** the Tribe's Wildlife and Outdoor Recreation Division, (WORD), did this day come before the Tribal Council to request that the Tribal Council adopt the non-Tribal Member Hunting Regulations for 2011-2012, as attached and incorporated hereto; and
- WHEREAS,** WORD staff advised the Tribal Council that the hunting seasons, bag limits and regulations are based on sound biological principles, surveys and methods; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has reviewed the recommended regulations and concurs that they will provide sustainable management of Tribal Wildlife resources; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds that the Non-Tribal Member Hunting Regulations for 2011-2012 are in the best interest of the Tribe as they serve to protect the Tribe's natural resources located within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby adopts the Non-Tribal Member Hunting Regulations for 2011-2012 presented by WORD and referenced herein.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **JUNE 1, 2011** duly adopted by a vote of **NINE** for and **ZERO** against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
