WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

(Hiring Robert Zahgotah at Whiteriver Maintenance)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") heard from Mr. Robert Zahgotah, a Tribal member, who is not currently employed for reasons discussed in Executive Session; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to hire Mr. Zahgotah to continue working for the Tribe at Whiteriver Maintenance.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Whiteriver Maintenance to hire Mr. Robert Zahgotah to continue his work for the Department.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **SEPTEMBER 7, 2011** duly adopted by a vote of **SEVEN** for and **ZERO** against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
