



**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**( Approving Re-establishment of McNary Community Library )**

- WHEREAS,** the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") is proud to offer a Library in the McNary area that provides books and services to Tribal Members residing on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation ("Reservation"); and
- WHEREAS,** the McNary Library ("Library") discontinued its operations due to severe roof damage that led to damp conditions, warped floors, damaged ceilings and walls; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribe has been notified that funds may be available through the Arizona State Library to purchase a building for a new library for the McNary Community; and
- WHEREAS,** the Librarian has met with the Land Office to begin the process of obtaining a parcel of land in the McNary vicinity for the establishment of the community library; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds it in the best of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the McNary Community to move forward with the re-establishment of the McNary Library and authorizes relevant Tribal personnel to solicit any available grant money or financial assistance to help the Tribe purchase a new building for the purposes described herein.


**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the re-establishment of the McNary Library and authorizes the solicitation of financial grants and awards to assist in rebuilding the library for the benefit of all Tribal Members with access to the McNary community.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that the Land Office is directed to assist in allocating a parcel of land to be designated for the location of the McNary Library.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on SEPTEMBER 21, 2011 duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (j), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
