

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

## (Approval for Filming Permit)

WHEREAS, the North Six Production Company produces commercial still photography for several major companies including the Tommy Hilfiger clothing company; and

WHEREAS, North Six contacted the White Mountain Apache Tribe to inquire whether they could produce photos for Tommy Hilfiger using the Salt River Canyon area as a setting; and

WHEREAS, North Six provided the Tribe with a proposed plan regarding the scale of the production; and

WHEREAS, to ensure compliance with the proposed plan and for security purposes the Tribe requested that a Game and Fish Ranger be present at all times; and

WHEREAS, the proposed plan was reviewed by the Tribal Council and the scale of the project did not represent a threat to the physical or cultural resources of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, North Six agreed to pay a per-day rate consistent with the industry standard to be allowed to use the area for the photo shoot; and

WHEREAS, issuance of a permit, consistent with the proposed plan, provides a financial benefit to the Tribe without negatively impacting Tribal resources.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the issuance of a filming permit to North Six Production Company consistent with the terms in the proposed plan.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall govern.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>OCTOBER 13, 2011</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
