

## WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Nation Exercising Self-Governance Over the Fort Apache Indian Reservation

## **Resolution No. 05-2012-56**

## (Approval to Grant Tribal Relinquishment Request of Nicholas J. West Bebo)

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Enrollment Code and the Tribal Constitution, the Tribal Enrollment Committee is designated to ensure that all requirements are met by each applicant who wishes to relinquish their tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Tribal Member, Nicholas J. West Bebo, has requested that his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that he may become eligible for enrollment with the Navajo Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Relinquishment of Tribal Head Rights form has been completed and signed by Nicholas J. West Bebo the presence of a Notary Public (see attached); and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee reviewed and approved this relinquishment request at a duly called meeting on February 28, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with the recommendation of the Tribal Enrollment Committee that the relinquishment from tribal membership be approved for Nicholas J. West Bebo.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the tribal relinquishment request of Nicholas J. West Bebo, along with any and all privileges accorded to members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe such as, but not limited to, hunting, fishing, and recreational privileges upon the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Office of Vital Records to remove Nicholas J. West Bebo from the membership rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, this Resolution shall be declared null and void and have no legal effect. This Resolution shall not be subject to Judicial Interpretation, only the Tribal Attorney, with the assistance of the Tribal Council Secretary, may opine on Tribal Council intent and the meaning of the language as used herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Acting Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution. In the event that the Chairman fails to delegate signatory authority to an Acting Chairman, the Vice-Chairman may sign provided that the Tribal Secretary and a Tribal Attorney attest to the veracity of the subject matter of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>May 16, 2012</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE</u> for and <u>ONE</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Tribal Constitution, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

## RELINQUISHMENT OF TRIBAL HEAD RIGHTS WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

	ur child who is an enrolled member
of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, under the age of 15 years, do hereby, of	
my free will, as an adult over the age of eighteen years, voluntarily and with full	
knowledge of making this decision, request the TRIBAL COUNCIL of the WHITE	
MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, WHITERIVER, ARIZONA, to release my/our child	
from the Tribal Census Rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to enable my/our child	
to enroll with the Navay Nata	
Further, I understand that my child will no longer have fishing or hunting privileges on	
the FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION; No home site or farmland assignments,	
or claim to have titles to any resources of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, or	
monies distributed pursuant to Judgment under the Indian Claims Commission Act.	
Further, that I must remove from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation within ninety (90)	
days after the Resolution date accepting my child's relinquishment, any livestock in said	
child's name. I further understand, however, that my child may reapply for enrollment in	
the White Mountain Apache Tribe upon reaching the age of eighteen (18), but that the	
Tribal Council has total, nonreviewable discretion to deny or grant said reapplication.
