Resolution No. 02-2013-44

(Rescinding CBO's Exclusive Authority over all Non-Emergency Medical Transportation)

WHEREAS, in years past, the Tribal Council had authorized the Client Business Office ("CBO") to provide oversight over all non-Emergency Medical Transportation; and

WHEREAS, due to CBO hours that do not extend beyond regular business hours, Tribal members have complained that the service offerings of the Tribe are lacking and that a need for additional transportation companies exists; and

WHEREAS, in order to move forward, the Tribal Council finds it in the Tribe's best interest to rescind the prior resolution that granted authority to the Client Business Office to oversee all non-emergency medical transportation functions.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby rescinds any and all resolutions granting the Client Business Office the exclusive authority to provide non-medical transportation services on the reservation. At a later date, the Council shall consider new regulatory policies that will govern over Transportation, which may or may not directly involve the Client Business Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, this Resolution shall be declared null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Acting Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution. In the event that the Chairman fails to delegate signatory authority to an Acting Chairman, the Vice-Chairman may sign.


The foregoing resolution was on **February 21, 2013** duly adopted by a vote of **SEVEN** for and **ZERO** abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Tribal Constitution, ratified by the Tribe

September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
