



# WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

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## **Resolution No. 03-2013-68**

### **( Approval of Future Land Development in McNary Area )**

**WHEREAS,** the Land Board addressed the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe (“Tribe”) on their role pursuant to the Tribal Land Code, which identifies the role of the Land Board Committee as preserving the Tribe’s land and resources through proper use and management of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation (“FAIR”); and

**WHEREAS,** the Land Board presented a map to the Tribal Council and expressed the need to open up more acreage for future land assignments in the community of McNary; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to authorize the specified land development request.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a total of 534 acres of land in the community of McNary to be opened up for future development, located at T8N, R23E and R24E, in sections 18,19, and 24; to be assigned by the Land Board at their discretion based on best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, this Resolution shall be declared null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Acting Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution. In the event that the Chairman fails to delegate signatory authority to an Acting Chairman, the Vice-Chairman may sign.

The foregoing resolution was on **MARCH 20, 2013** duly adopted by a vote of **SEVEN** for and **ZERO** against and **ZERO** abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Tribal Constitution, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
