## **Resolution No. 04-2013-81**

**( Renaming the Hon-Dah Substation to “Tenny Gatewood Public Safety Complex” )**

**WHEREAS,** the White Mountain Apache Police Department (“WMAPD”) requested to the Tribal Council to consider renaming the Hon-Dah Substation to the “Tenny Gatewood Public Safety Complex” in memory of the late Officer Tenny Gatewood; and

**WHEREAS,** Officer Tenny Gatewood, was a dedicated law enforcement official who devoted his life and spent the majority of his time defending and protecting the people of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation (“FAIR”); and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council honors Officer Gatewood and the White Mountain Apache Tribe continues to share memories of his generosity, diligence and overall service to the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds it in the Tribe’s best interest to rename the Hon-Dah Substation to honor the late Officer Tenny Gatewood and thanks him for his service to the Tribe.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request to rename the Hon-Dah Substation to the “Tenny Gatewood Public Safety Complex.”

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, this Resolution shall be declared null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Acting Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution. In the event that the Chairman fails to delegate signatory authority to an Acting Chairman, the Vice-Chairman may sign.

The foregoing resolution was on APRIL 16, 2013 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Tribal Constitution, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
