

## WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approval of Utility Payments for the East Fork Community Building)

WHEREAS, District II Councilman, Kino Kane, presented to the Tribal Council of the need to pay utility expenses for continued public use of the East Fork community building; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to pay \$125.00 for electricity expenses and \$250.00 for propane expenses.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes payment to Navopache Electric Company in the amount of \$125.00 and payment to the Apache DOXOL Office in the amount of \$250.00.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>JANUARY 21, 2014</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against with <u>ZERO</u> abstaining by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
