

WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approval to Cover Burial Expenses for Reno Johnson Sr.)

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that a well known public servant for the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Reno Johnson Sr., passed away on May 11, 2014 and that funeral arrangements are pending; and
- WHEREAS, Reno Johnson Sr., served the White Mountain Apache Tribe for many years as a Chief of Police for Law Enforcement, District IV Council Member, Tribal Vice-Chairman, Tribal Chairman and was well known for his duties as a Pastor for his church, the Canyon Day Lighthouse Family Church; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council extends its sincere sympathy to the Johnson family finds it in the best interest to provide assistance to the Johnson family as a gesture of support during this difficult time of mourning; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal Treasurer to pay for the funeral expenses, in the amount of \$5,635.15, through the already budgeted burial expense account.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Treasurer to pay for the funeral expense for the decedent, Reno Johnson Sr., through the already budgeted burial expense account.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on MAY 14, 2014 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against with ONE abstaining by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
