A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approving the Purchase of Decals for Tribal Vehicles)

- WHEREAS,** the Property/Inventory Control Management department presented the Tribal Council with quotes for the purchase of Tribal Seal decals for vehicles owned and/or operated by the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** all vehicles owned and/or operated by the Tribe, with the exception of Tribal Council member vehicles, shall receive decals to be placed on the driver's door and the front passenger door of each vehicle; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Treasurer shall make arrangements for the purchase of all necessary vehicle decals; and
- WHEREAS,** the Purchasing Department shall issue invoices to each department for reimbursement of the cost of all decals to be used by each department; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council reviewed the matter and approved the purchase of Tribal Seal decals for Tribal vehicles because it is in the best interest of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the purchase of Tribal Seal decals to be placed on the driver's door and front passenger door of all vehicles owned and/or operated by the Tribe, with the exception of Tribal Council member vehicles.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Treasurer shall purchase all vehicle decals, and the Purchasing Department shall issue invoices for reimbursement of the cost of the decals to each department.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.




