(Accepting Head Start Monthly Report)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, on this day, has heard from Director Leola Larzelere on the latest developments occurring under the Tribal Head Start umbrella. The Tribe has agreed to receive a monthly report to ensure that Head Start is complying with its grant and other agreements that are used to support the program; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council continues to support the Head Start program and finds it in the Tribe's best interest to accept this regularly scheduled monthly report in order to remain in compliance with grant and other Federal requirements.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it declares that it has received the Head Start Program monthly report as required by contract and other Federal requirements and thanks and continues to support Head Start Director Leola Larzelere in her effort to improve the program for the benefit of our Apache children.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>AUGUST 6, 2014</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>FOUR for, ZERO</u> against, and <u>TWO</u> abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
