



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approval to Grant Tribal Membership for Augustine Joseph Case)

WHEREAS, the family of the late Augustine Joseph Case, provided testimony to the Tribal Council about his lineage to the Cibecue Community and the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, based on the testimony provided in executive session, the Tribal Council concurs with the Case family and finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to authorize tribal membership of the late Augustine Joseph Case.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants tribal membership for the late Augustine Joseph Case.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or Federal Laws, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on MARCH 04, 2015 duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for, ZERO against, and THREE abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
