



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approval of the DreamBuilder and DreamCatcher Programs)

WHEREAS, the Thunderbird School of Global Management and the Freeport-McMoRan Foundation seek to offer the online DreamBuilder program and on campus DreamCatcher programs to women entrepreneurs from the White Mountain Apache tribe. Both programs are co-created with Thunderbird and funded by the Freeport-McMoRan Foundation; and

WHEREAS, the Thunderbird School of Global Management and the Freeport-McMoRan Foundation seek approval from the Tribal Council to promote these program and to recruit potential applicants from the community; and

WHEREAS, the Thunderbird School of Global Management and the Freeport-McMoRan Foundation seek the designation of a tribal contact to coordinate the dates and logistics of promotion of these programs within the community; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration the Tribal Council has determined that the DreamBuilder and DreamCatcher programs are in the best interest of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants Thunderbird School of Global Management and the Freeport-McMoran Foundation permission to promote the DreamBuilder and DreamCatcher programs in the community and hereby appoints Colleen Faden as the Tribal contact person with whom to coordinate promotion.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on JULY 8, 2015 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for, ZERO against, and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so


