(Transfer Line-Item Budgeted for Queen from the Fair and Rodeo Office's Budget to the Culture Center's Budget)

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Queen is the official royal representative of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, former White Mountain Apache Tribal Queens worked at the Culture Center. The Culture Center does not have a line-item for the Queen in its budget and the Fair and Rodeo Office's budget does have a line-item for the Queen; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees to transfer the remaining line item budgeted for the Queen from the Fair and Rodeo Office's budget to the Culture Center's Budget.



BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the transfer of the remaining line-item budgeted for the Queen from the Fair and Rodeo Office's budget to the Culture Center's Budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on September 09, 2015 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for, ZERO against, and TWO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
