



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Lower Qualifications for Child Find Director and Social Services Director)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been in search of a qualified Tribal member to carry out the responsibilities of the Social Services Director and the Child Find Director; and

WHEREAS, the selection of a qualified applicant for each position has proven difficult and after considering the qualifications for each position, the Tribal Council agrees it is in the Tribe's best interest to lower the qualifications for the Child Find Director position and the Tribal Social Services Director position.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requires the Child Find Director to have a Bachelor's Degree in Special Education and/or Early Childhood Education.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requires the Social Services Director to have a Bachelor's Degree in Social Work but a Masters in Social Work is preferred.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on September 9, 2015 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for, ZERO against, and ONE abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
