(Approving Certification of the Primary Election Results)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 8 of the Tribal Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, the Tribal Council adopted an Election ordinance which mandates that a Primary Election be held on the first Wednesday of February during an election year; and

WHEREAS, the Primary Election was held by the White Mountain Apache Tribe on Wednesday, February 3, 2016, wherein Tribal Council Candidates submitted their names to a vote of the people for Council Offices in Districts I, II, and IV; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Election Commission has certified to the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Primary Election is complete and has been carried out in accordance with provisions of the Tribal Constitution and the Election Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and has certified that of the total of 1,859 ballots cast, the following number of votes were received by the individuals listed below whose names were on the ballot for the following offices:





BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **FEBRUARY 4, 2016** duly adopted by a vote of **11** for, **ZERO** against, and **ZERO** abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
