

WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Removing the Moratorium on Radio Reports for Tribal Council)

WHEREAS, it is customary for members of the Tribal Council, including Chairman and Vice-Chairman, to cease their local radio reports on KNNB-FM prior to the election period to maintain a semblance of fairness and to curtail the potential abuse of airtime for political purposes; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 10-2015-204, imposed a moratorium on radio reports for Tribal Council and political candidates for the duration of the election period; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe that the cessation of radio reports by Tribal Council members be lifted and that reports may resume as scheduled, effective immediately.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that all radio reports on KNNB-FM for the Chairman, Vice Chairman and Tribal Council resumes as scheduled, effective immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>APRIL 13, 2016</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>ELEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against with <u>ZERO</u> abstaining by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
