(Feast For the Future Evaluation Request)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in conjunction with Johns Hopkins University has conducted research projects for over 35 years which aim to raise the level of health of all residents of the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Feast for the Future project has been a great success with the White Mountain Apache Tribe and other American Indian tribes but to provide evidence that the curriculum is effective we are requesting additional evaluation measures; and

WHEREAS, the additional evaluation instruments will be used to enhance our understanding of the impact of the Feast for the Future Program components on participants and the community and this project will allow participating communities to develop and implement a program beneficial to their community; and

WHEREAS, the additional evaluation instruments will include the following:

- FGD Guide for ESG Youth_v1_2-9-16
- FGD Guide for ESG Teachers v1 2-11-16
- IDI Guide for School Administrators v1 2-11-16
- FGD Guide for Adult FFF Participants v1 2-9-16
- FGD Guide for CAB Members v1 2-9-16

- TFEP Farmer Elder Survey v1 2-11-16
- TFEP Youth Survey v1 2-11-16

and participants will sign consent to participate in the additional evaluation measurers prior to the evaluation being conducted.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request the additional evaluation measures and consent forms for those measures of the Feast for the Future Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests for an update and overview of the evaluation analysis once the project has been completed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>APRIL 22, 2016</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE</u> for, <u>ZERO</u> against, and <u>TWO</u> abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
