(Approving and Accepting the Summer Youth Initiative for White Mountain Apache Tribe Game & Fish Department)

WHEREAS,	the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") is entrusted by the Tribe's Constitution to act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe, to manage all economic affairs and enterprises of the Tribe, and to regulate subordinate organizations for economic another purposes; and		
WHEREAS,	the Tribal Council desires to increase Natural Resource and Wildlife Conservation careed development opportunities for White Mountain Apache Tribal Youth; and		
WHEREAS,	funding is available through the Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA") for the Summer Youth Initiative for the White Mountain Apache Tribe Game & Fish Department (Department); and		
WHEREAS,	the Department – seeks to utilize available funding opportunities in the accomplishment of it mission to provide and conduct quality education and outreach, while surveying and managin wildlife and fish on Tribal land; and		
WHEREAS,	the Department - successfully conducted a Summer youth conservation program in the summer of 2015, using funding from the BIA; and		
WHEREAS,	BIA Grant A16AV00693 information has been provided by the Department to obtain approval for the White Mountain Apache Tribe Game & Fish Summer Youth Initiative such program involve education, outreach, and internship training while surveying and managing wildle and fish on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation ("FAIR"); and		
WHEREAS,	this project is expected to provide a superior learning and career development opportunity for White Mountain Apache Tribal Youth; and		
WHEREAS,	the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognizes and appreciates the cultural and ecological significance of encouraging and supporting Tribal youth through diverse educational and career opportunities, on the FAIR, and intends to promote, cultivate, and maintain Tribal youth development; and		
WHEREAS,	given the urgency of the funding, the Tribal Council further finds that the grant application and acceptance of funds needs to be considered and made outside of its regularly scheduled meeting; and		

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finds that: (1) this Resolution may be voted upon by signature of a member of the Tribal Council where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (2) the Tribal Council Secretary should attempt to obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (3) no signature would mean that the respective Tribal Council member is against this Resolution, (4) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period

of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the White Mountain Apache Tribe Game & Fish Summer Youth Initiative.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts the BIA Grant A16AV00693, to carry out the White Mountain Apache Tribe Game & Fish Summer Youth Initiative.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Game and Fish Department to work with the Tribe's Controller, Treasurer, and Grants and Contracts Manager to establish an account for said grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that given the urgency of the request described herein, this Resolution may be voted upon as follows: (a) by signature of a member of the Tribal Council, including the Chairman of the Tribal Council and the Vice-Chairman of the Tribal Council, where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (b) the Tribal Council Secretary shall attempt to obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (c) no signature shall mean that the respective Tribal Council member is against this Resolution, (d) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature, and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
