

## WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Assisting Barney Gregg with Educational Expenses)

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed that Tribal member, Barney Gregg, is currently pursuing his forestry degree at Northern Arizona University; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Gregg expressed his interest and long-term commitment in pursuing his forestry degree in order to assist the Tribal Forestry and the Tribe in its carbon credit investments; and
- WHEREAS, Forest Manager, Logan Lawson, concurs with the commitment of Mr. Gregg and provided the Tribal Council with a history of the services provided by Mr. Gregg, to the Tribal Forestry Program; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to assist Barney Gregg, with educational expenses, in the amount of \$6,500.00, for two (2) semesters.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Barney Gregg to receive assistance, in the amount of \$6,500.00 per semester, for two (2) semesters, for his forestry degree at Northern Arizona University.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Tribal Forestry to utilize funds generated from carbon credit sales to cover such expenses for Mr. Gregg, so long as he remains in compliance with his educational expense contract.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>AUGUST 24, 2016</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for, <u>ZERO</u> against, and <u>ONE</u> abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so
