



Resolution No. 10-2016-218B

WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Appointing Yvonna Redsteer to the Land Restoration Board)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council enacted the White Mountain Apache Tribe Land Restoration Code and the code provides for a seven-member Land Restoration Board, authorized to review and approve land restoration projects; and

WHEREAS, there is a vacancy on the Land Restoration Board and Yvonna Redsteer has been recommended to fill the vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe concurs with the recommendation to appoint tribal member, Yvonna Redsteer, to the Land Restoration Board.



BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Yvonna Redsteer to serve on the Land Restoration Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on OCTOBER 19, 2016 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for, ZERO against, and ZERO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
