

WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Authorizing Burial of Non-Tribal Member Guy"Joe"Sands)

WHEREAS,	passed the Tribal Council has been advised that Guy "Joe" Sands away and that funeral arrangements are pending; and
WHEREAS,	the Family requests that the Tribal Council authorize the deceased, Guy"Joe"Sands, to be buried at the Cedar Creek Red Hills Cemetery; and
WHEREAS,	although Guy"Joe"Sands, was not a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, the Tribal Council finds that the request made herein should be granted; and
WHEREAS,	the Tribal Council finds that the assistance provided herein is consistent with the culture and tradition of White Mountain Apache and in sympathy to the family; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the Family to bury the late Guy"Joe"Sands at the Cedar Creek Red Hills Cemetery.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>Demeber 5, 2016</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>10</u>		
for, \nearrow against, and \bigcirc abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain		
Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in		
Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and		
federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18,		
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
