(Approving Land Restoration Scholarship Recipients for Spring 2017)

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Land Restoration Code states that a portion of the Land Restoration Fund reserved for scholarships for Tribal members pursuing degrees in Natural Resources or related fields; and

WHEREAS, the scholarship recipients were selected in accordance with guidelines outlined in the Land Restoration Code and the application process established by the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Land Restoration Board selected the following students for scholarship awards for the Spring 2017 academic year: Jerry Alsenay, Vino Burnette, Jr. and Charmayne Lynn Dayaye.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby concurs with the Land Restoration Board and authorizes the Tribal Treasurer to issue scholarship awards to Jerry Alsenay, Vino Burnette, Jr. and Charmayne Lynn Dayaye with funds allocated through the Land Restoration's budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on JANUARY 25, 2017 duly adopted by a vote of VOTE for, VOTE against, and VOTE abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
