



# WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

## ( Approval for Filming Permit for Imagination Television )

**WHEREAS,** Karena and Kasey’s Foreign Flavours is a travel and food television series, from New Zealand’s Imagination Television Production, that visit countries across the world with a focus of learning about local cultures and cuisines by visiting local restaurants, markets and food destinations, including talking to chefs, cooks and food experts; and

**WHEREAS,** Imagination Television expressed an interest in coming to the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to learn more about the Native American culinary traditions and culture; and

**WHEREAS,** a proposed filming permit has been submitted and reviewed by the Office of the Attorney General and the scale of the project does not represent a threat to the physical or cultural resources of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** Imagination Television has coordinated with local Chef Nephi Craig, Ndee Bikiyaa The People’s Farm and Arrowhead Café to conduct such filming and requests the issuance of a filming permit.



**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the issuance of a filming permit to Imagination Television for filming on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and as detailed in the proposed filming permit.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on MARCH 22, 2017 duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for, ZERO against, and TWO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
