



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Certifying Citizen Participation in the FY 2017 Indian Community Development Block Grant Application Process)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe (“Tribe”) has designated the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority (“WMAHA”) as its Tribally Designated Housing Entity; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 01-2017-57, the Tribe approved and authorized the WMAHA to apply for a fiscal year 2017 Indian Community Development Block Grant (“ICDBG”) Housing Rehabilitation grant on behalf of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe, by and through the WMAHA, has solicited the views of tribal members about the use of ICDBG funds through public meetings and request for written comments in compliance with 24 CFR 1003.604(a), and has considered the comments of its membership in the 2017 ICDBG application;

WHEREAS, given the urgency of the grants submittal timeline, the Tribal Council further finds that the 2017 ICDBG grant application needs to be considered and made outside of its regularly scheduled meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finds that: (1) this Resolution may be voted upon by signature of a member of the Tribal Council where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (2) the Tribal Council Secretary should attempt to obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (3) no signature would mean that the respective Tribal Council member is against this Resolution, (4) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby certifies that the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority has met the requirements related to citizen participation, as defined at 24 CFR 1003.604 for the fiscal year 2017 ICDBG Housing Rehabilitation application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that given the urgency of the request described herein, this Resolution may be voted upon as follows: (a) by



signature of a member of the Tribal Council, including the Chairman of the Tribal Council and the Vice-Chairman of the Tribal Council, where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (b) the Tribal Council Secretary shall attempt to obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (c) no signature shall mean that the respective Tribal Council member is against this Resolution, (d) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature, and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.


