

WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approving a Rodeo Bible Camp)

- WHEREAS, Fire On The Mountain Church, in conjunction with Cowboy at the Cross Ministries, would like to offer an opportunity for local youth to receive basic and fundamental techniques of rodeo events along with ministry; and
- WHEREAS, the Cowboy at the Cross Ministries will be providing insurance during this event, including the expense coverage for use of electricity at the facility; and
- WHEREAS, the Rodeo Bible Camp is scheduled for July 27-30, 2017, at the Tribe's Fair & Rodeo Arena; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Council further finds that the Tribe should provide: Port-A-Johns, security provided by Tribal Police Department for duration of camp, EMT'S services for duration of camp, tribal entities help to teach fitness, nutrition, and drug awareness.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a Rodeo Bible Camp to be hosted at the Tribe's Fair and Rodeo Arena by the Fire on the Mountain Church and Cowboy Cross Ministries, with in-kind support from the Police Department, Public Works and EMS Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on MAY 3, 2017 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for, ZERO against, and TWO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
