(Approval of Land Restoration Projects for Fiscal Year 2017-2018)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council enacted the Land Restoration Code to set aside twenty percent of the 22-H judgment funds for the establishment of a perpetual and permanent White Mountain Apache Land Restoration Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Land Restoration Board requests the Tribal Council to provide final approval for the following projects: Daniel Pusher, (Acting) Water Quality, North Fork of White River Stream Bank Stabilization Project, Emily Maheux and Clayton Harvey, Ndee Bikiyaa, Farm-to-School Initiative, Emily Maheux and Sheena Harris, Ndee Bikiyaa, Summer Farm Camp, David Newlin M. Newlin, Little Colorado River Plateau, Grant Monies to Purchase Farming and Ranching Equipment for the Cibecue Community, Brenda Begay, EPO, E-Waste Collection Event, Brenda Begay, EPO, Community Action and Revitalization Program, Javis Davis, Tribal Non-Point Source Coordinator, Lofer Cienega, Swamp Spring and Turkey Spring; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with the Land Restoration Board and finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to approve the above listed projects.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes approval of the following projects: Daniel Pusher, (Acting) Water Quality, North Fork of White River Stream Bank Stabilization Project, Emily Maheux and Clayton Harvey, Ndee Bikiyaa, Farm-to-School Initiative, Emily Maheux and Sheena Harris, Ndee Bikiyaa, Summer Farm Camp, David Newlin M. Newlin, Little Colorado River Plateau, Grant Monies to Purchase Farming and Ranching Equipment for the Cibecue Community, Brenda Begay, EPO, E-Waste Collection Event, Brenda Begay, EPO, Community Action and Revitalization Program, Javis Davis, Tribal Non-Point Source Coordinator, Lofer Cienega, Swamp Spring and Turkey Spring.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.


The foregoing resolution was on JUNE 7, 2017 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for, ZERO against, and ZERO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
