

WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approval of Head Start 2017-2018 Budget)

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has legal and fiscal responsibility for administering and overseeing the Head Start Program, including the safeguarding of Federal funds, review applications for funding, documents, and amendments; and

WHEREAS, the Head Start Program presented their 2017-2018 fiscal year budget which begins on December 1, 2017 through November 30, 2018, in the amount of \$2,042,886.00; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to approve the 2017-2018 fiscal year budget for the Head Start Program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the 2017-2018 fiscal year budget for the Head Start Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>SEPTEMBER 27, 2017</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for, <u>ZERO</u> against, and <u>ONE</u> abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
