



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Advertising Agreement for the Division of Transportation Fort Apache Connection)

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe's Division of Transportation has developed an advertising agreement to sell advertising space on the Fort Apache Connection transit for the display of commercial advertising; and

WHEREAS, the advertising agreement has been reviewed by the Tribe's Attorney General's Office; and

WHEREAS, the advertising agreement is a live document subject to updates in the advertising terms and conditions and advertising statement of purpose.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Division of Transportation's advertising agreement as a live document, subject to updates and amendments.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on OCTOBER 25, 2017 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for, ZERO against, and ONE abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
