

WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approval of Road Names in the Community of Cibecue)

- WHEREAS, through the White Mountain Apache Tribe's ("Tribe") Division of Transportation ("DOT") and Fire Department it is supported that all roads are named and placed in the 911 Emergency Addressing System; and
- **WHEREAS**, the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority ("WMAHA") plans to develop new homes in the community of Cibecue, access road are needed; and
- WHEREAS, to remain consistent with the military theme road names in the area the DOT and Fire Department have developed the names of Veteran Drive, West Sergeant Way, and South Major Lane the new access roads; and
- **WHEREAS,** the access roads will be entered into the 911 Emergency Addressing System as well as the DOT Road Inventory once construction is complete.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the road names Veteran Drive, West Sergeant Way, and South Major Lane for the new roads that will service the new WMAHA development.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>DECEMBER 13, 2017</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>ELEVEN</u> for, <u>ZERO</u> against, and <u>ZERO</u> abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
