



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approval of the Division of Transportation/ Fort Apache Connection Maintenance Plan)

WHEREAS, the Division of Transportation/ Fort Apache Connection (“FAC”) Transit Program is funded under the Federal Transit Administration (“FTA”) and provides public transit services on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council understands the necessity to provide a safe public transit service; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Transportation/ Fort Apache Connection Maintenance Plan is a live document subject to updates annually; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to approve the Division of Transportation/ Fort Apache Connection Maintenance Plan as set forth by the Federal Transit Administration.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby approves the Division of Transportation/ Fort Apache Connection Maintenance Plan as a living document, subject to annual updates.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **FEBRUARY 20, 2018** duly adopted by a vote of **EIGHT** for, **ZERO** against, and **ZERO** abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
