Authorization for the Division of Transportation to apply for the Bureau of Indian Affairs Office of Justice Services Indian Highway Safety Program Grant for Occupant Protection)

the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") through their Division of Transportation ("DOT") WHEREAS. would like to submit an application to apply for the Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA") Office of Justice Services ("OJS") Indian Highway Safety Program ("IHSP") Grant under the category of Occupant Protection; and

the funding will be used to assist and fully establish the Child Passenger Safety Seat Program WHEREAS. through a partnership with the Tribe's Fire and Rescue Department; and

the Tribal Council authorizes the Division of Transportation to apply for the BIA OJS IHSP WHEREAS. Grant for Occupant Protection.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Division of Transportation to apply for the Bureau of Indian Affairs Office of Justice Services Indian Highway Safety Program Grant for Occupant Protection.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

> The foregoing resolution was on APRIL 11, 2018 duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for, ZERO against, and THREE abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
