

## WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Appointing School Board Members to Riverside Indian High School, Chemawa Indian School and Sherman High School)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has the responsibility of appointing individuals to serve as school board members on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and that such representation should come from within the governing body; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to appoint Jerold Altaha to serve on the Riverside Indian School Board, Alvena Bush to the Chemawa Indian School Board and Jerome Kasey to the Sherman Indian School Board.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Jerold Altaha to serve on the Riverside Indian School Board in Anadarko, Oklahoma, Alvena Bush to serve on the Chemawa Indian School Board and Jerome Kasey III to serve on the Sherman Indian School Board.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairwoman, or in her absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>MAY 30, 2016</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for, <u>ZERO</u> against, and <u>ZERO</u> abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
