

## WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

## A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Appointment of Fair and Rodeo Commissioners)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council appointments Fair and Rodeo Commissioners, on a voluntary basis, to manage the annual White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair & Rodeo festivities; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to appoint Shyanne Early-Duane, Shannon Farley, Ethan Dazen, Rupert Lupe Sr., Randell Declay, Sisto Hernandez, Ricardo Velasquez, and Rose Kasey to serve as Fair and Rodeo Commissioners.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Shyanne Early-Duane, Shannon Farley, Ethan Dazen, Rupert Lupe Sr., Randell Declay, Sisto Hernandez, Ricardo Velasquez, and Rose Kasey to serve as Fair and Rodeo Commissioners.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairwoman, or in her absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on MAY 30, 2018 duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against with TWO abstaining by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
