

WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approval for Johns Hopkins to Purchase a Plaque)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was informed of Mike and Ellen Kullman's significant financial contribution to the Johns Hopkins Center for American Indian Health specifically for the Native Vision program for the purpose of renovating the walking trail located at the Fair Grounds on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with the recommendation to place a plaque at the trailhead of the Fair Grounds Trail to commemorate the Kullman's generous contribution.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes a plaque to be placed along the trailhead of the Fair Grounds Trail by the John Hopkins Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairwoman, or in her absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

> The foregoing resolution was on MAY 9, 2018 duly adopted by a vote of **ELEVEN** for, **ZERO** against, and **ZERO** abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
