

WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approval for a Temporary Permit for Commercial Photography for Necessary Productions to Photograph a Ford Print Advertisement)

- **WHEREAS**, Necessary Productions expressed an interest in coming to the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to photograph a Ford print advertisement; and
- **WHEREAS**, a proposed Temporary Permit for Commercial Photography has been submitted and reviewed by the Office of the Attorney General and the scale of the project does not represent a threat to the physical or cultural resources of the Tribe; and
- **WHEREAS**, Necessary Productions has agreed to all terms, conditions, and fees associated with the Temporary Permit for Commercial Photography for still photograph within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to approve the Temporary Permit for Commercial Photography for Necessary Productions to photograph a Ford print advertisement as detailed in the Temporary Permit.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the issuance of Temporary Permit for Commercial Photography for Necessary Productions to photograph a Ford print advertisement on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairwoman, or in her absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>AUGUST 10, 2018</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>VOTE</u> for, <u>SIX</u> against, and <u>ZERO</u> abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so

ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
