



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approval of Head Start Budget, Self Assessments, Training & Professional Development Plan and Program Information Report for 2018-2019)

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Head Start Program (“Head Start”) and the White Mountain Apache Tribe provide valuable early childhood development services to the children of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the 2018-2019 budget begins December 1, 2018 through November 30, 2019 and ensures coverage of expenses for 252 children and 49 employees; and

WHEREAS, the development of the White Mountain Apache Head Start Program Training & Professional Development Plan derives from the information gathered from the annual self assessments, program information reports, Teaching Strategies Gold and Staff Professional Development Plans to strengthen areas of concern and promotes continued improvements; and

WHEREAS, self assessments are done by the Head Start staff at the end of each school year and identifies strengths and goals for improvement. There are nineteen services areas and each services area has a goal and desired outcome; and

WHEREAS, it is the fourth year for the non-competitive five year under 445 C.F.R. & 1307.7 and satisfactory performance under the terms and conditions of the Head Start grant is in the best interest of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to approve the Head Start budget and its supporting documents for fiscal year 2018-2019.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Head Start Program’s budget and its supporting documents for fiscal year 2018-2019.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairwoman, or in her absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **SEPTEMBER 12, 2018** duly adopted by a vote of **NINE** for, **ZERO** against, and **TWO** abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
