A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approval of Head Start School Readiness Goals and Annual Report)

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Head Start Program ("Head Start") and the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") provide valuable early childhood development services to the children of the reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the annual budget for the Head Start Program requires a school readiness goals and an annual report; and
- WHEREAS, is the fourth year for the non-competitive five year under 445 C.F.R. & 1307.7 and satisfactory performance terms and condition of the Head Start Program and therefore the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to approve the school readiness goals and the annual report.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the 2018/2019 School Readiness Goals and the 2017/2018 Annual Report for the Head Start Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairwoman, or in her absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **NOVEMBER 19, 2018** duly adopted by a vote of **TEN** for, **ZERO** against, and **ZERO** abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
