(Authorizing a Memorandum of Agreement with the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona for the Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program)

WHEREAS, the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc. (“ITCA”) entered into a contract with the Arizona Department of Health Services (“ADHS”) Bureau of Women and Children’s Health (“BWCH”) to implement Tribal Teen Pregnancy Prevention (“TTPP”) Programs with five Tribes; and

WHEREAS, in November 2011, the ADHS contract identified Tribes that ITCA, Inc. could enter into a subcontract with and one of those Tribes was the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Health Programs has managed the funding and services of the TPPP and desires to continue such programs among Tribal youth on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the TTPP Program aims to reduce the number of teen pregnancies through the provision of year round, community based, multi faceted youth development/service learning programs utilizing the Wyman-Teen Outreach Program (“TOP”) Model or other evidenced-based comprehensive teen pregnancy prevention youth development curricula approved by ADHS; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to renew the Memorandum of Agreement with the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona for the Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes to renew the Memorandum of Agreement with the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona for the Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program for fiscal year 2018/2019, beginning November 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2019.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairwoman, or in her absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **FEBRUARY 20, 2019** duly adopted by a vote of **ELEVEN** for, **ZERO** against, and **ZERO** abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
