



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approval of Land Board's Recommendation for 18 Applicants)

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") is entrusted by the Tribe's Constitution to act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe, to manage all economic affairs and enterprises of the Tribe, and to regulate subordinate organizations for economic and other purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Land Board members have come before the Tribal Council requesting approval of 18 land applications consisting of 0 relinquishments, 17 home sites, 1 farmlands, and 0 business application. The governing body will approve their formal adoption to maintain the historical record for any future purpose or review by the public; and

WHEREAS, the applications presented derive from Land Board Meetings from April 2019 through May 2019 and consists of approvals from prior and newly appointed Land Board members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the applications presented and concurs with the recommendation of the Land Office and finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to approve the pending applications.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the 18 applicants consisting of 0 relinquishments, 17 home sites, 1 farmlands, and 0 business application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairwoman, or in her absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on **JULY 3, 2010** duly adopted by a vote of **NINE** for, **ZERO** against, and **ONE** abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
