



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approving Site Work Contract for Rainbow Treatment Center with Whiteriver Construction, Inc.)

WHEREAS, The Rainbow Treatment Center is a Tribal program which offers substance abuse treatment and other programs to enhance the well-being of individuals and families; and

WHEREAS, Rainbow Treatment Center has earned funds which it has saved and budgeted for placement of additional modular offices at its premises in McNary, Whiteriver, and Cibecue; and

WHEREAS, Representatives from Rainbow Treatment Center have negotiated a contract with Whiteriver Construction, Inc., (“Contractor”) to perform the site preparation work, utility connections and sidewalk and parking lot installation for each of the three locations (attached and incorporated herein by reference); and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has, this day, reviewed and discussed the final contract documents between the Tribe and the Contractor; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council finds that the terms and conditions are appropriate and that their approval is in the Tribe’s best interests.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the contract between the Tribe and Whiteriver Construction, Inc., for the site work, utility connections and sidewalk and parking installation and related tasks for the work to prepare for modular office installation for Rainbow Treatment Center at its premises in McNary, Whiteriver, and Cibecue.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it authorizes and directs the Tribal Chairwoman to execute and deliver the agreements on behalf of the Tribe and directs that the project activities commence as specified in the contract agreements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairwoman, or in her absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on SEPTEMBER 12, 2019 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for, ZERO against, and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on September 30, 1993, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
