# (Approving Primary Election Results and Certification of Candidates for the General Election)

WHEREAS, Article VI of the Tribal Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Constitution") requires regular elections to be held for Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Article VI, Section 8 of the Constitution, the Tribal Council adopted an Election Ordinance which mandates that a Primary Election be held on the first Wednesday of February during an election year, established by Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution; and

WHEREAS, The White Mountain Apache Tribe held its 2020 Primary Election on Wednesday, February 5, 2020, wherein Tribal Council candidates submitted their names to a vote of the people for the office of Tribal Council Representative in District IV; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Election Commission has certified to the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Primary Election is complete and has been carried out in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution and the Election Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and has certified that of the total of 1,439 ballots cast, the following number of votes were received by the individuals listed below whose names were on the ballot for the following office:

## **DISTRICT IV:** (Canyon Day/Whiteriver/North Fork/Hon-Dah/McNary)

WHEREAS, Primary Election contests were not held for the Offices of District I Council Representative, District II Council Representative or District III Council Representative because there were not enough candidates running for office to require a primary contest; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Election Commission has certified that the candidates for Tribal Council office in the 2020 General Election to be held on April 1, 2020 are as follows:
