(Approving Technical Amendment to Resolution No. 02-2022-12, Approving 2022
Primary Election Results and Certification of Candidates
for the General Election)

- WHEREAS, Article VI of the Tribal Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Constitution") requires regular elections to be held for Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, Pursuant to Article VI, Section 8 of the Constitution, the Tribal Council ("Council") adopted an Election Ordinance that mandates that a Primary Election be held on the first Wednesday of February during an election year, established by Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, The White Mountain Apache Tribe held its 2022 Primary Election on Wednesday, February 2, 2022, wherein Tribal Council candidates submitted their names to a vote of the people for the office Tribal Chairperson; and
- WHEREAS, Primary Election contests were not held for the Offices of District I Council Representative, District II Council Representative, District IV Representative or the Office of Vice Chairman because there were not enough candidates running for office to require a primary contest; and
- WHEREAS, On February 3, 2022, the Tribal Election Commission certified to the Tribal Council that the Primary Election was complete and was carried out in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution and the Election Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- **WHEREAS,** The Election Commission certified that 2,998 ballots were cast with the following number of votes being received by the individuals listed below whose names were on the ballot for the following office:

Office of the Tribal Chair

1. Rea Goklish	854
2. Gwendena Lee-Gatewood	905
3. Kasey Velasquez	1,241

;and

- WHEREAS, A technical error was made in the total voter participation which stated that 2,998 ballots were cast; however, it should read that 3,000 ballots were cast; and
- WHEREAS, As the number of votes per candidate was certified correctly, the number of ballots cast for each candidate remains the same despite the technical error in the total voter participation; and
- WHEREAS, This technical error occurred due to a power outage at the Seven-Mile Precinct that resulted in two (2) ballots not being submitted electronically, but required manual submission to the Automated Election Services ("AES") to be counted; and
- **WHEREAS,** The correction of the technical error does not change the candidates certified to be on the ballot for the 2022 General Election to be held on April 6, 2022; and
- WHEREAS, A true copy of the corrected Election Commission Certification of Election Results is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and
- WHEREAS, The Council acknowledges the need to correct the technical error in order to ensure the integrity of the election process, reaffirming the importance that every vote counts in Tribal elections.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the technical amendment provided herein and the corrected Certification of the Primary Election results submitted by the Tribal Election Commission is hereby accepted and approved and the attached corrected Certification of the Primary Election results is incorporated herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the candidates in the April 6, 2022 Tribal General Election remain as follows:
