

## WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

## A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Appointing Theodore Roosevelt School Board Members)

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation provides, at Article IV, Section 1(s) that the Tribal Council ("Council") shall exercise the power, "To regulate its own procedures, to appoint subordinate committees, commissions, boards, advisory or otherwise..."; and

**WHEREAS,** The Council has the responsibility of appointing individuals to serve on the school board for the Theodore Roosevelt School; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that appointing the following individuals to serve on the Theodore Roosevelt School Board is in the best interests of the Tribe and its members:

- Alvena Bush;
- Crystal Declay;
- Amy George;
- Lorene Billy;
- Cheyenne Burnette;
- Alyandra Aday; and
- Regina Yazzie.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Alvena Bush, Crystal Declay, Amy George, Lorene Billy, Cheyenne Burnette, Alyandra Aday and Regina Yazzie are hereby appointed to serve on the Theodore Roosevelt School Board, effective immediately and until subsequent Council action.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the previous members of the Theodore Roosevelt School Board are hereby dismissed with thanks for their hard work and contributions to the school.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

## Resolution No. 05-2022-144

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on MAY 23, 2022 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for, THREE against, and ZERO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on November 10, 2021, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
