

WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Approval of Head Start 2022-2023 Budget, 2022 Self Assessment, Training & Professional Development Plans for 2022-2023, Community Assessment for 2022-2023, School Readiness Goals and an Annual Report for 2022)

- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation provides, at Article IV, Section 1(s) that the Tribal Council ("Council") shall exercise the power "To regulate subordinate organizations...", and
- WHEREAS, The White Mountain Apache Head Start Program ("Head Start") and the Tribe provide valuable early childhood development services to the children of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The Head Start budget for fiscal year 2022-2023 is up for renewal; and
- WHEREAS, The Head Start Program compiled a 2022-2023 budget and a 2022 Self-Assessment, Head Start Training and Professional Development Plans for 2022-2023, Community Assessment for 2022-2023, School Readiness Goals, and an Annual Report for 2022 ("Supporting Documents"); and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to approve the Head Start budget and all Supporting Documents for fiscal year 2022-2023; and
- WHEREAS, given the urgency of an approaching deadline, the Tribal Council further finds that the annual budget renewal needs to be considered and made outside of its regularly scheduled meeting; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finds that: (1) this Resolution may be voted upon by signature of a member of the Tribal Council where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (2) the Tribal Council Secretary should attempt to obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (3) no signature would mean that the respective Tribal Council member is against this Resolution, (4) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Head Start budget and all Supporting Documents for fiscal year 2022-2023.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that given the urgency of the request described herein, this Resolution may be voted upon as follows: (a) by signature of a member of the Tribal Council, including the Chairman of the Tribal Council and the Vice-Chairman of the Tribal Council, where a signature indicates a vote for this Resolution, (b) the Tribal Council Secretary shall attempt to obtain signatures for members of the Tribal Council personally, (c) no signature shall mean

that the respective Tribal Council member is against this Resolution, (d) the Tribal Council Secretary should wait no longer than a reasonable period of time to obtain a vote by signature or by no signature, and so indicate that this Resolution was presented to the respective member of the Tribal Council for a vote.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
