



WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

A Sovereign Tribal Nation

(Appointing Land Restoration Board Members)

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Article IV Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Reservation (“Constitution”), *inter alia*, the Tribal Council (“Council”) shall exercise the power to represent the Tribe and act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Two vacancies currently exist on the Land Restoration Board and it has been recommended that Consoni Hill and Ivan Walker, Jr., be appointed to fill both positions; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council concurs with the recommendation to appoint Consoni Hill as a District IV Representative and Ivan Walker, Jr. as a Young Adult Representative.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Consoni Hill to serve as District IV Representative and Ivan Walker, Jr. to serve as a Young Adult Representative on the Land Restoration Board for a term of one, two or three years to be determined at an official Land Restoration Board meeting.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on JANUARY 10, 2023 duly adopted by a vote of TEN for, ZERO against, and ZERO abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on November 10, 2021, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
